

Project Overview

The City of Carson and its partners are investing in improving the San Diego Freeway (I-405) at Wilmington Avenue Interchange. This area is a heavily used transportation route for both the commuting public and freight haulers. These improvements will enhance safety, improve traffic flow and reduce congestion associated with the volume of trucks and vehicles accessing the freeway every day from nearby businesses.

Improvements:

- **NEW Addition:** Northbound I-405 On-Ramp at Wilmington Avenue
- Widening of Wilmington Avenue between E. 223rd Street to E. 220th Street
- Ramp Modifications
- Traffic Signal Synchronization
- Bridge Retrofit over Dominguez Channel
