



CLOSURE LIST NOTICE

WHAT: The contractor will set k-rail and restripe the San Diego Freeway (I-405) between Alameda Street and Carson Street. This work includes the closure of freeway lanes and ramps.

WHEN: Overnight, Tuesday, November 12
Wednesday, November 13

WHERE: Northbound and Southbound I-405 between Alameda Street and Carson Street.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

**Overnight, Tuesday, November 12
between 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

Northbound I-405 between Alameda Street to Carson Street: Up to three lanes will be CLOSED. One-freeway lane will remain open to traffic.

Northbound I-405 Carpool Lane between Alameda Street to Carson Street: Full lane closure.

Northbound and Southbound I-405 On-ramps at Wilmington Ave: Full ramp closures.

**Overnight, Wednesday, November 13
between 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

Northbound I-405 between Alameda Street to Carson Street: Up to two lanes will be CLOSED. Two lanes and the carpool lane will remain open to traffic.

Southbound I-405 between Carson Street and Alameda Street: One lanes will be CLOSED. Three lanes and the carpool lane will remain open to traffic.

Northbound and Southbound I-405 On-ramps at Wilmington Ave: Full ramp closures.

Noise: You will experience noise from back-up alarms, work crews and other related equipment during working hours.

Dust Mitigation: Water trucks will be on-site and used to minimize dust during working hours.

Lighting: Additional lighting is required for the safety of the public and the crews.

Note: Construction activity schedules and closures are subject to change.
