

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TEMPORARY NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND I-405 RAMP CLOSURES AND WILMINGTON AVENUE TRAFFIC SHIFT

SOUTHBOUND I-405 OFF-RAMP TEMPORARY CLOSURES – NIGHT WORK

WHAT: The contractor has completed excavation and will continue with additional construction activities for the retaining wall at the **southbound I-405 off-ramp at Wilmington Ave.**

WHEN:

- **Equipment delivery, installation and preparation for 1st concrete installation:** Thursday night, October 2 and Friday night, October 3, 2014
- **1st Concrete Placement:** Monday night, October 6, 2014
- **Erection of Temporary Wall Forms:** Thursday night, October 9, 2014
- **2nd Concrete Placement:** Monday night, October 13, 2014

WORK/RAMP CLOSURE HOURS: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

TEMPORARY LANE TRANSITION & SIDEWALK CLOSURES ON WILMINGTON AVE. – NIGHT WORK

WHAT: The contractor will continue with the widening of Wilmington Ave. including the construction of the new sidewalk on the east side of Wilmington Ave. This will require overnight ramp closures for the traffic shift of northbound traveling lanes into the center lanes of Wilmington Ave. to allow for vegetation removal, sidewalk removal and construction of new sidewalk. Sidewalk access will be closed on the east side of Wilmington Ave. and is recommended that pedestrians use the west side sidewalk of Wilmington Ave. **Driveway access will be maintained at all times.**

The temporary traffic shift and sidewalk closure will be in effect for **approximately 7 months.**

WHEN: Monday night, October 13, 2014 (*one night only for the implementation of the traffic shift*)

WHERE: On Wilmington Avenue between 220th St. and 223rd St.

WORK/RAMP CLOSURE HOURS: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

The temporary lane transitions will require the closure of northbound and southbound I-405 on- and off-ramps at Wilmington Ave.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING ACTIVITIES

Noise/Vibration: You may experience noise and vibration from back-up alarms, work crews and other related construction equipment.

Flagmen: You may experience travel restrictions on Wilmington Avenue. Flaggers will be on site to ensure safe traffic traveling and access to driveways. **Use caution when driving through construction zones.**

Access: Business access will be maintained at all times. **Dust Mitigation:** Water trucks will be used to minimize dust.
