

TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURE ON 223RD STREET

WHAT

As a part of the construction activities in the project area, Southern California Edison (SCE) will remove and replace existing Edison poles along 223rd Street (north side) between Wilmington Avenue and slightly east of Del Taco driveway and along 223rd Street (north side) between Wilmington Avenue and slightly east of the Carson Nissan dealership. This work will require the **temporary closure of the 223rd Street westbound lane closest to the street curb**, between Wilmington Avenue and slightly east of the Del Taco driveway. *Access to businesses will be maintained at all times*.

After considerable coordination, SCE determined on Friday, June 3, 2016, in the afternoon, that conducting the work and lane closure on Monday, June 6, 2016 would help expedite this work by leveraging the existing construction conditions being implemented by the contractor in the same area.

WHERE

Temporary Lane Closure

On 223rd Street between Wilmington Avenue and slightly east of the Del Taco driveway. (223rd Street westbound lane closest to the street curve, in front of the Shell gas station and Del Taco.)

Monday, June 6, 2016*

WORK HOURS

7 a.m. to 5 p.m.*

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING ACTIVITIES

<u>Noise</u>: You may experience noise from back-up alarms, work crews and other construction related equipment and activities.

Flagmen: Flaggers will be onsite when necessary to allow access to traffic.

Access: Local business and resident access will be maintained at all times.

Dust Mitigation: Water trucks will be used to minimize dust.
