

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TEMPORARY PARTIAL CLOSURES OF NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND I-405 & NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND I-405 ON-RAMPS, AT WILMINGTON AVENUE

WHAT Starting on Monday night, August 1, 2016, as a part of the project's improvements the contractor will pour asphalt concrete on the two outer lanes closest to the shoulder of both northbound and southbound I-405 at Wilmington Avenue as well as on northbound and southbound I-405 on-ramps at Wilmington Avenue. This activity will require **nightly partial lane closures and ramp closures of the areas where the asphalts concrete will be poured.** Please see below for alternate on-ramps. Detour signs will be posted.

WHERE

- Northbound and southbound I-405 at Wilmington Avenue
- Northbound and southbound I-405 on-ramps at Wilmington Avenue

WHEN

Monday, August 1 – Tuesday, August 2, 2016*
nightly closures

TEMPORARY CLOSURES

- Outer two lanes closest to the shoulder on I-405 at Wilmington Avenue
- I-405 on-ramps (in both directions) at Wilmington Avenue

WORK HOURS

10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

ALTERNATE ON-RAMPS

- Northbound I-405 on-ramp at Alameda Street
- Northbound I-405 on-ramp at E. Carson Street
- Northbound I-405 on-ramp at Avalon Boulevard

Note: Construction activity schedules and closures are subject to change due to inclement weather and/or other uncontrollable factors.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING ACTIVITIES

Noise: You may experience noise and vibrations from back-up alarms, work crews and other construction related equipment and activities.

Flagmen: Flaggers will be onsite when necessary to allow access to traffic.

Access: Business and resident access will be maintained at all times.

Dust Mitigation: Water trucks will be used to minimize dust.

Use caution when driving through construction zones.
