

# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE Overnight Work

## REMOVAL OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON UTILITY LINES OVER I-405 AND OF UTILITY POLES ON WILMINGTON AVENUE

### WHAT

As a part of the project improvements, Southern California Edison (SCE) will de-energize and switch over existing copper and fiber optic lines on Wilmington Avenue at I-405 by Friday, March 24, 2017. This work will be followed by the removal of these utility lines currently over the I-405 freeway as well as by removal of utility poles on Wilmington Avenue. In order to conduct the removals, SCE will implement **intermittent partial traffic breaks on both northbound and southbound I-405, in increments of 5-15 minutes (there will be no full freeway closures)**. In addition, at least one southbound lane and both northbound lanes on Wilmington Avenue will remain open. This activity will be conducted at night to lessen the impact on daytime traffic. *Please see below for additional information on work schedule and location of activities.*

### WHERE

#### Removal of Utility Lines

On northbound and southbound I-405 at Wilmington Avenue

#### Removal of Utility Poles

On Wilmington Avenue (west side of the street) between Pooch Hotel and 220<sup>th</sup> Street.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING ACTIVITIES

**Traffic backup:** You may experience traffic back up during the intermittent 5-15 minutes traffic breaks.

**Noise/Vibrations:** You may experience vibrations and noise from back-up alarms, work crews and other construction related equipment and activities.

**Flagmen:** Flaggers will be onsite when necessary to allow access to traffic.

**Access:** Business and local resident access will be maintained at all times.

**Dust Mitigation:** Water trucks will be used to minimize dust.

**Lighting:** Extra lighting will be used for the night work.

**Use caution when driving through construction zones.**
