### FINAL PAVING ACTIVITY: I-405 OFF-RAMP CLOSURES

#### UPDATES

**WHAT** As a part of the project's final stage improvements, the crews are continuing with final paving operations. The contractor, OHL, will implement final paving operations at the northbound and southbound I-405 off-ramps at Wilmington Avenue.

This activity will require the **temporary closures of northbound (partial closure) and of southbound (full closure) I-405 off-ramps at Wilmington Avenue.** *Please see below for additional information. Access to local residents and businesses will be maintained.*

#### WHEN/WORK HOURS

Friday, Dec. 15 – **Monday, Dec. 18**, 2017 • 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. \*(Continuous day & night work and closure)\*

#### WHERE

Northbound (**partial ramp closure**) and Southbound (**full ramp closure**) I-405 off-ramps at Wilmington Avenue.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING ACTIVITIES

**Noise/Vibrations:** You may experience vibrations and noise from back-up alarms, work crews and other construction related equipment and activities.

**Flagmen:** Flaggers will be onsite when necessary to allow access to traffic.

**Access:** Business and local resident access will be maintained at all times.

**Dust Mitigation:** Water trucks will be used to minimize dust.

**Lighting:** Extra lighting will be used for the night work.
