

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

NIGHT WORK AND CLOSURES

WHAT As a part of the project’s final stage improvements, the contractor will implement the following activities:

1. Full northbound Wilmington Ave. closure between 223rd St. and I-405 Bridge
 - a. **Why:** UPRR (United Pacific Railroad) will conduct panel installation
 - b. **When/Work Hours:** 10 p.m. Monday night, February 5 through 4 a.m. Tuesday, February 6*
 - c. **Detour:** please see image below for detour information

2. 55-Hour Weekend Closure of Southbound I-405 on-ramp at Wilmington Ave.
 - a. **Why:** Pavement restoration
 - b. **When/Work Hours:** 10 p.m. Friday night, February 2 through 5 a.m. Monday, February 5 (Continuous day & night work and closures)*

3. Partial Street Night Closures of 223rd St. and Wilmington Ave.

(One lane will remain open in each direction of both streets.)

 - a. **Why:** Electrical wiring for street light detecting loops
 - b. **When/Work Hours:** Monday, February 5 through Thursday, February 8, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.*

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING ACTIVITIES

Noise/Vibrations: You may experience vibrations and noise from back-up alarms, work crews and other construction related equipment and activities.

Flagmen: Flaggers will be onsite when necessary to allow access to traffic.

Access: Business and local resident access will be maintained at all times.

Dust Mitigation: Water trucks will be used to minimize dust.

Lighting: Extra lighting will be used for the night work.
